

# Old Nags Head Place

## Trash and Recycling Information

### 2021

The Town of Nags Head has three Trash routes: Blue, Green and Red.

**All Old Nags Head Place houses are on the *Blue Route*.** Sanitation collection takes place **EARLY** in the morning so sanitation carts must be rolled out the **NIGHT BEFORE** scheduled collections.

- **SUMMER** - Roll out Trash on **Sunday night** and **Thursday night**. Roll out Recycling on Sunday night.
- **WINTER** - Roll out Trash carts on **Sunday night** and **Thursday night**. Roll out Recycling on Sunday night

- All sanitation carts must be placed at the edge of the roadway with the lid opening facing the street and a spacing of three feet between carts.

- Sanitation carts should be removed from the edge of the roadway and pulled **BACK** to the house as soon as possible on the **SAME DAY** as collection.

- If Trash in your carts was not picked up, it may be due to one of the following reasons: cart blocked due to a parked vehicle, cart was overflowing, cart was facing the wrong direction, carts were too close together or the cart contained non-household trash such as yard debris.

Old Nags Head Place Homeowners are encouraged to obtain the correct **Blue Route Stickers** (see below) for their sanitation carts and **Blue Route Clings** for display on their refrigerators. Stickers and Clings can be obtained from the Public Works Facility, 2200 Lark Avenue, Nags Head (off 8<sup>th</sup> street behind the Bowling Alley). Clings only can be obtained from Nags Head Town Hall, 5401 S. Croatan Hwy, Nags Head. **Homeowners are encouraged to post Trash instructions for renters over or near kitchen garbage cans (see last page of document).**

## SANITATION CART ETIQUETTE

Sanitation collection is **EARLY** (3 a.m. in summer and 5 a.m. in winter) so you must roll out your sanitation cart the day **BEFORE** the scheduled collection.

**Always remove carts from the edge of the roadway and place in a secure location as soon as possible on the same day as collection.**

## Town of Nags Head Offering Subscription-Based Recycling Service

Starting May 1, 2021 TFC Recycling (<http://www.tfc recycling.com>) will be providing a \$9/month subscription-based curbside recycling service to Nags Head homeowners. The Town is building a list of potential

subscribers until the TFC call center is operational. If you are interested, please call the Town at 252-441-122 and provide contact information. TFC will follow-up and call each homeowner.

Homeowners will contract directly with TFC for the recycling service, which will cost \$9/month. To encourage curbside recycling, the Town is subsidizing TFC's bid of \$14/residence by \$5. TFC will bill homeowners directly for the service. **Collection of recyclables will take place on Mondays all year long.** Home Owners can also take recycling items to drop off points in the Town.
